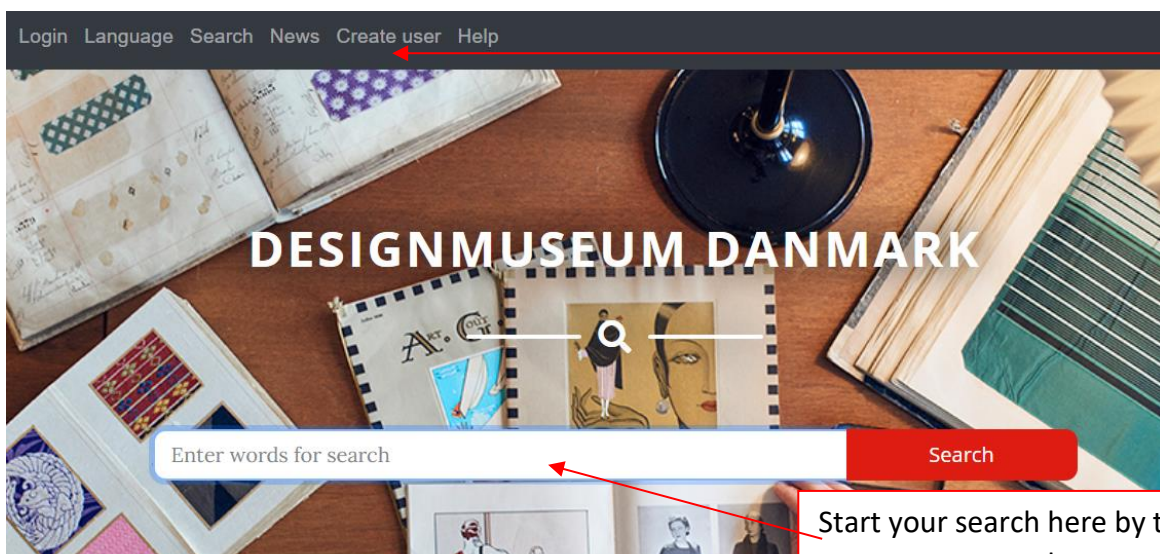

Create a user and/or login to order and loan books.

CPR-digits (yellow id card) are used as your loaner id and login. A 4-digit password is used as your pin-code, prompted at your first login. This combination (login + 4-digit password) is also your login to the self-loan machine in the library. If you are a first-time user and have created an account online, please identify yourself with an ID to the librarian present. You cannot order or loan until a librarian has verified your account.

Click on the **title** or **book cover** to see more information.

Click on the **title** again to 'close' the book and return to the list view.

How do I find the book?

Look at '**shelf**'. In this case listed as B50, meaning that the book is located in the reading room on shelf section B-50. If there is no letter but merely a shelf-number, (e.g: II25829) write it down on a piece of paper and the librarian will retrieve it from storage. The shelf number consists of a roman numeral (I, II, III or IV) and a number.

Unfolding the title will show more information such as *publisher, size, and description*.

This will also open the options for **order and loan**.

Click the **title** again to return to the list view.

Filter the search:

You can filter your search by using the facets on the left, such as *language, year, type* etc. by clicking them on and off.

Hyperlink:

Some of the words and terms in any given title are clickable and will prompt a new search.

Be aware that this is only possible in the list-view, and that terms are in Danish.

Advanced search

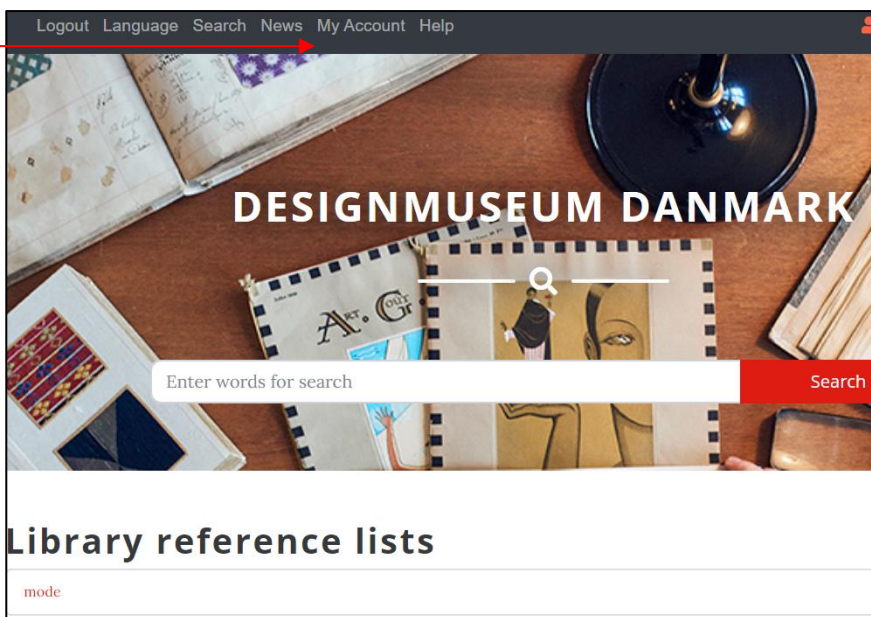

The regular loan period is 30 days. Books can be returned on the self-loan machine in the reading room. Outside opening hours, books can be returned in the black box outside the library door. You can renew your loans from your account page (see below).

Account

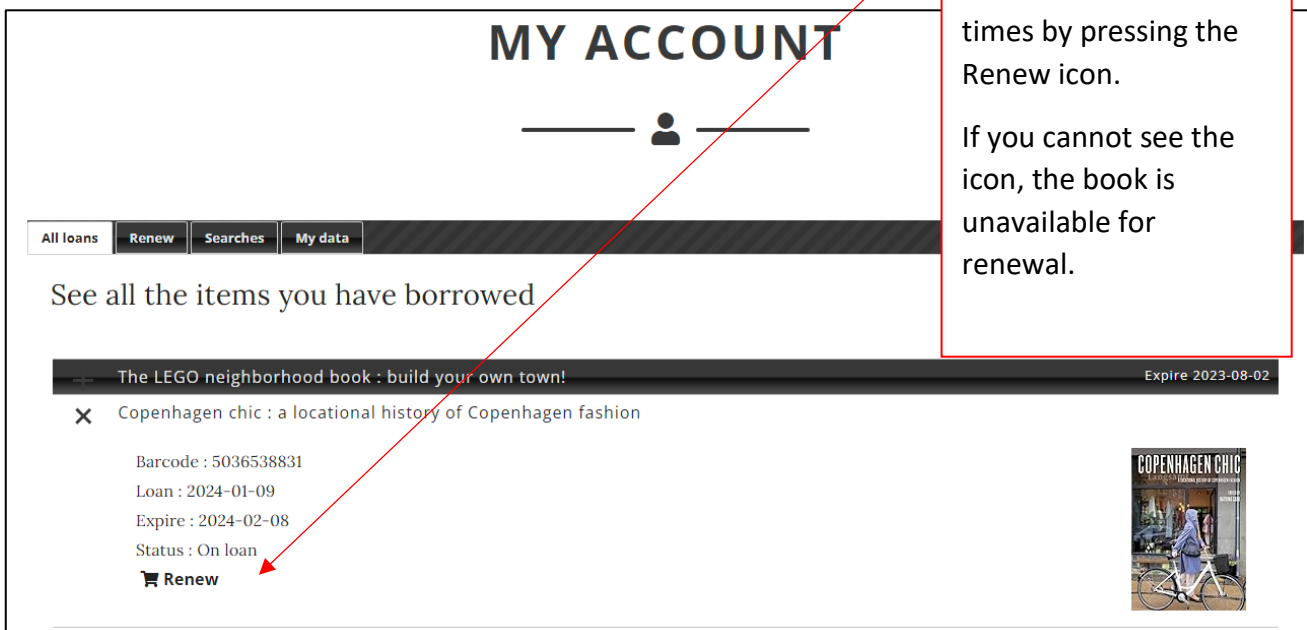
At the bottom of the front page, you can access your account details and loans. You can edit personal information and see search history.



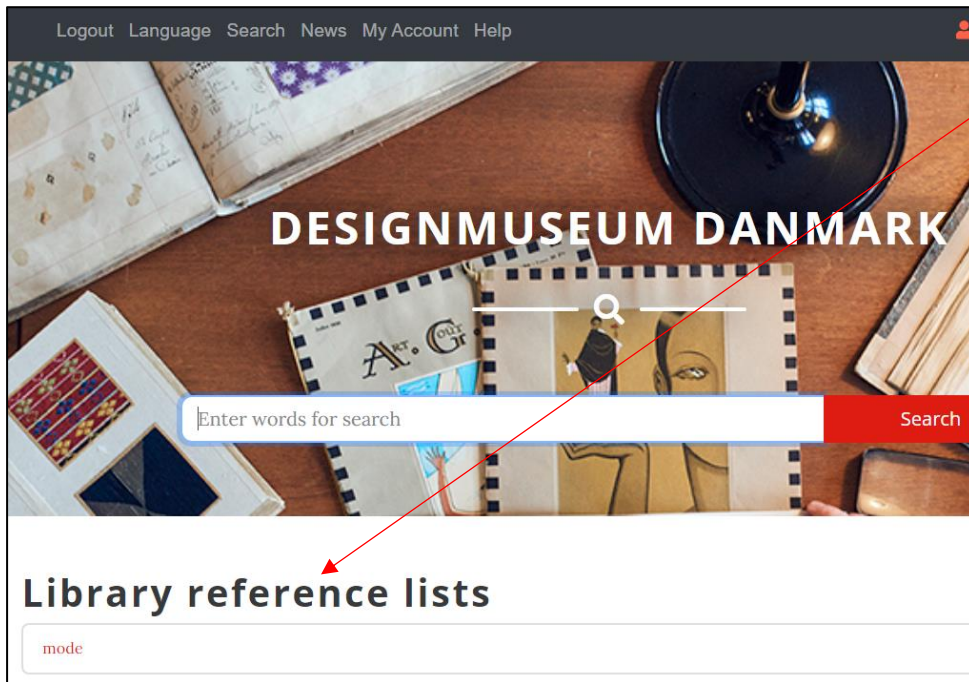
Renew:

Reference lists can be accessed from the front page when created.

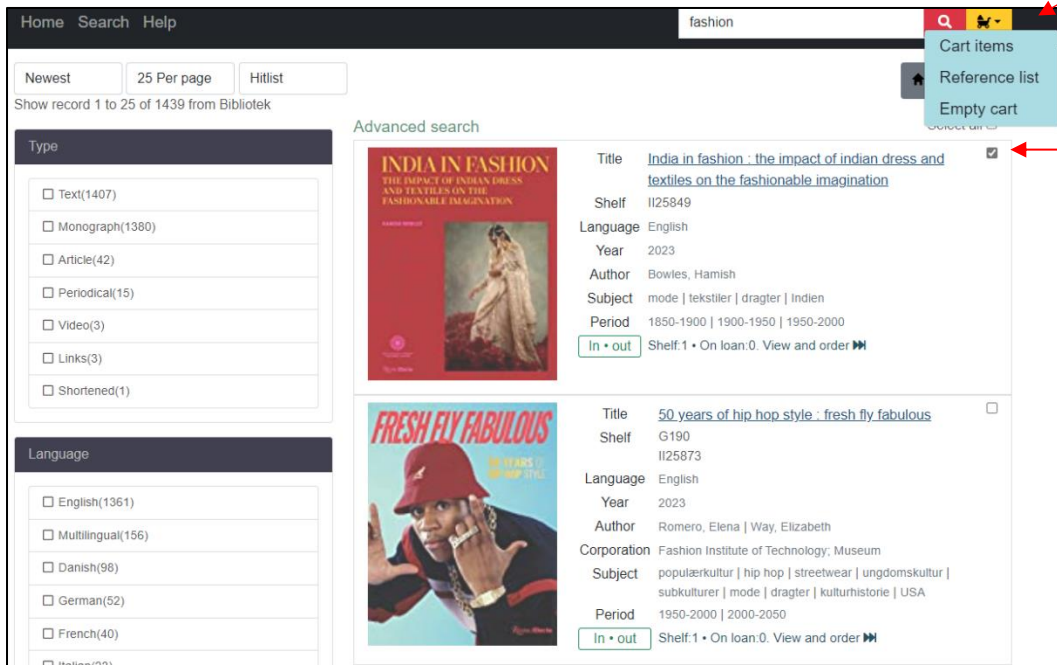
To make a **reference list**:
